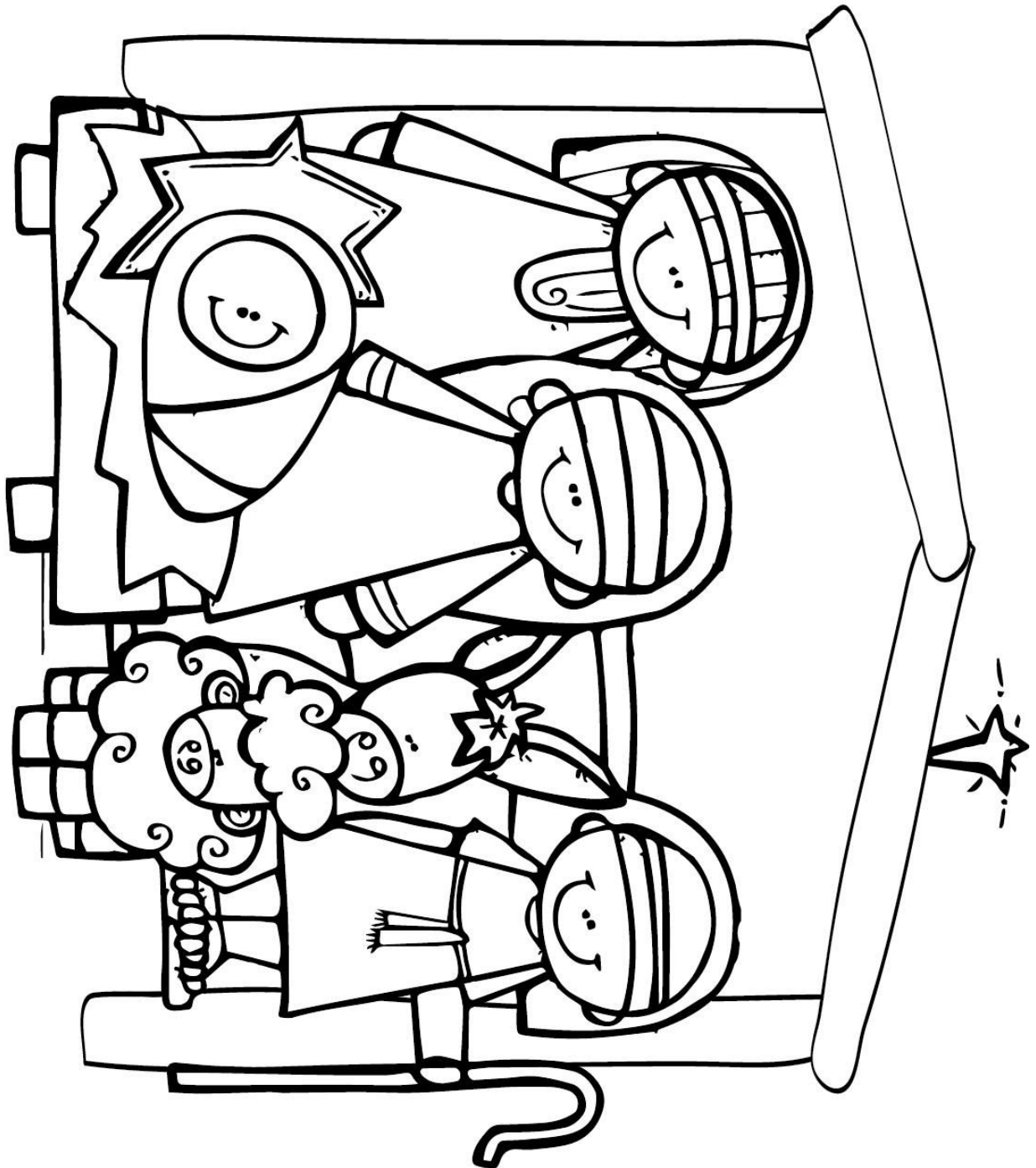

Read the Scriptures: **John 1:4; 10:10; 3:36**

Background:

The gospel of John presents Christ as the longed for Messiah and Son of God. He came for his own, and his own people did not receive Him (John 1:11). But many people did believe in Him, and “to all who did receive Him, who believed in His name, he gave the right to become children of God (John 1:12)”. By believing in Him, all people everywhere in the world, whatever their ethnic background, may enjoy life, true life, eternal life, in the name of Jesus (John 20:31)
