

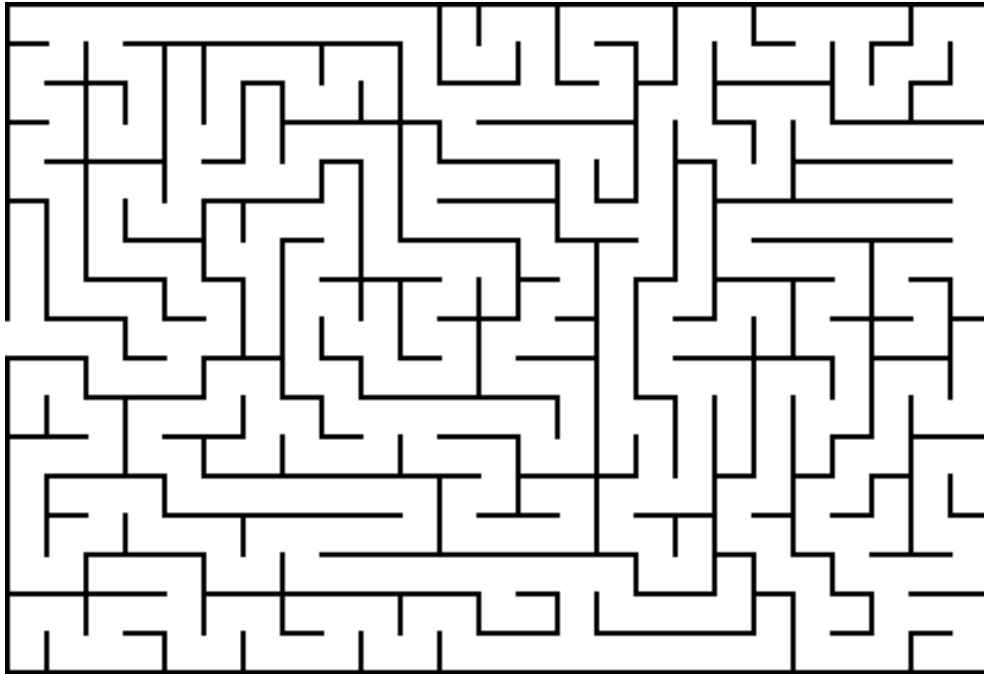

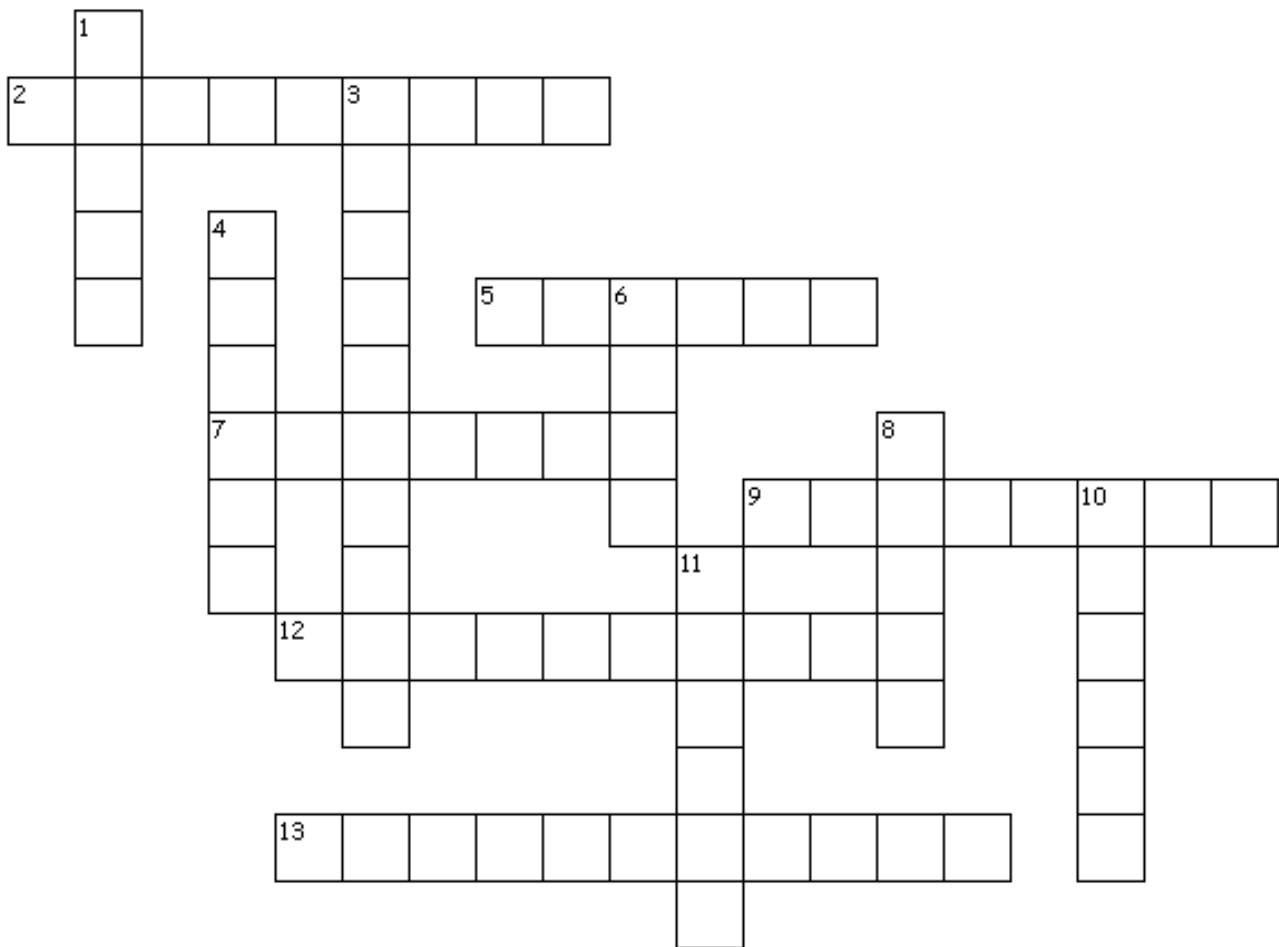

Read the Scriptures: **Luke 24 : 45 – 49**

Background:

3 days after Jesus' death and burial, God raised him from the dead. He appeared to different people such as His disciples. At first, the disciples did not believe when they were told about Jesus' empty tomb. Even when they finally believed, they still did not understand from Scripture why Jesus had to rise from the dead.

3. What is written in the Scriptures about Christ? (v46)

4. What will be preached in his name? What does "all nations" mean? (v47)

5. Who are the witnesses? (v48)

6. What is promised by the Father?

Which city did Jesus tell them to stay at? (v49)

Interpretations:

1. What will lead to the forgiveness of sins?

2. What are the things that a believer of Christ will witness?

3. What is the "power from on high" that the Father had promised? (c.f. Acts 1: 8)

Applications:

1. What is your personal understanding from this passage of Scripture?

2. How often do you allow the Holy Spirit to lead your actions and behaviour in life? Give examples.

3. How can you be a witness (good example for Christ) to your family and friends?
