# **Declaration of Rukun Negara**

The Rukun Negara was formulated and formally promulgated by Malaysia's Yang Di-Pertuan Agong on 31st August 1970, on Malaysia's 13th National Day. The Department of National Unity, under the direction of the National Operations Council (NOC), spent nearly a year drafting a national ideology meant to bond Malaysia's diverse population.

## **The declaration of Rukun Negara in full:**

**Indeed, our country Malaysia aspires to achieving a greater unity for all her peoples :**

- Maintaining a democratic way of life ;
- Creating a just society in which the wealth of the nation shall be equitably shared ;
- Ensuring a liberal approach to her rich and diverse cultural traditions, and ;
- Building a progressive society which shall be oriented to modern science and technology;

**We, the people of Malaysia, pledge our united efforts to attain these ends, guided by these principles:**

- Belief in God
- Loyalty to King and country
- Supremacy of the constitution
- Rule of Law
- Good behavior and morality
